NEW STRATEGIC INITIATIVES

- Ensure that future curriculum development incorporates school's foundations Biblical Christian Worldview, mastery learning and character development.
 - Mastery Learning: Standardising assessment and remediation for Prep, Year 1-2, Year 3-6, Year 7-10
- Offer a whole school educational programme that is compliant with the current version of Australian Curriculum.
 - Australian Curriculum: Familiarisation with v9.0.
 - Review units in 2023 as they are being taught
- Develop cohesive Literacy and Numeracy curriculum across Prep Year 10.
 - Numeracy: Implementation of Oxford Math from Prep Year 6
 - Numeracy: Continuation of JacPlus (Year 7-10)
 - Literacy: Implementation of Jolly Phonics transition statements between Year Levels as well as ensuring students are following on from previous year levels (eg. not skipping parts of the curriculum when moving up Year Levels).
- Expand curriculum to include STEM, Horticulture, and enhanced sporting opportunities.
 - Sporting Opportunities: Intramural table tennis competition (involve student leaders)
- Identify, facilitate and support professional development for staff in relevant areas with special emphasis on Australian Curriculum, Learning Support, and specialised curriculum areas being developed.
